PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Micro Certificate in Spoken Samskritam (MCSS) is a 6-quarter program that brings an appreciation of the language through everyday conversations. Designed for students with a basic understanding of Devanāgari script but lacking fluency in spoken Samskrtam, this 9-credit hour journey offers an immersive experience in mastering conversational proficiency. Through real-life scenarios, vocabulary building, and engaging skits, learners refine their pronunciation (pathanam), listening skills (śravanam), conversation (sambhāṣanam), and comprehension (avagamanam). With 1.5 credit hours per quarter, the MCSS perfectly complements HUA's CPSP, and transforms Samskrtam into a living, breathing language, inviting the student to connect deeply with its culture and wisdom in a joyful and profound way.
